**IT'S always a risk getting your loved one's name tattooed on your body. While we're sure Rachael Taylor has far greater worries at the moment, she has a permanent reminder of her relationship with ex Matthew Newton on her wrist.**

Taylor and Newton reportedly tattooed each other's names on the inside of their wrists in Los Angeles just a few months after becoming an item last year.

They followed a growing celebrity trend. Lara Bingle and Michael Clarke did it, as did Johnny Depp when he dated Winona Ryder, and Angelina Jolie inked a large tattoo of Billy Bob Thornton's name on her arm before they divorced.

"It really depends on how deep the tattoo is," Janesse Taylor-Saar, of Skinmedics Clinic in Pymont told us. "People come in often for this kind of thing, wanting to have a name or something else removed from their body, like funny little flowers or butterflies."

Ms Taylor-Saar described the treatment as "uncomfortable" but not painful. "Generally people come in here in a big hurry and they are so relieved once it's gone," she said.
